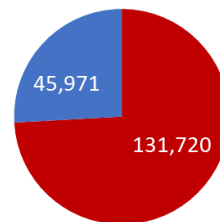

Please have your child wear jeans or bib overalls with a white solid color shirt on the day of the Christmas program (12/15).



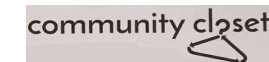
Singing and Soup Sunday, December 15

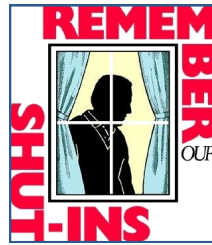
