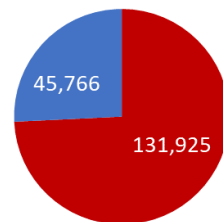

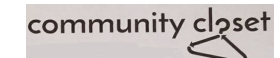

HAZEL MOFFATTE is recovering from pneumonia.

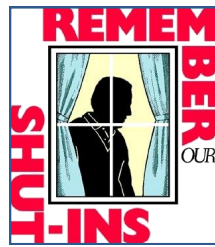
BOB SUMMERFIELD was discharged from the hospital last Tuesday and admitted into the Newaygo Medical Care Facility for rehabilitation.

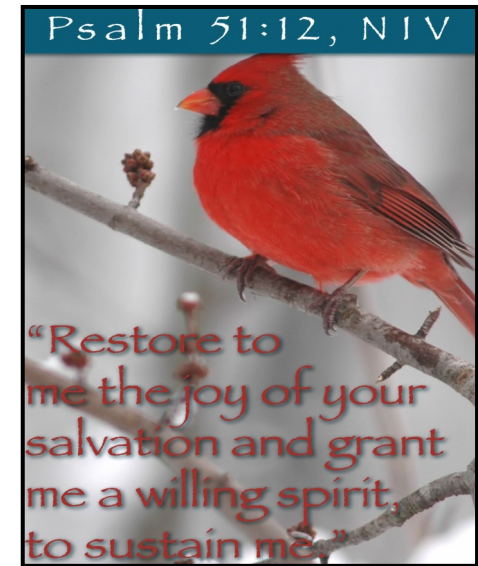
