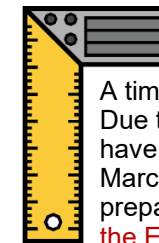
A variety of boxes are needed for packing. Please put them under the table in the foyer.

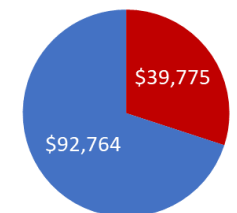


Building to Serve Construction Corner

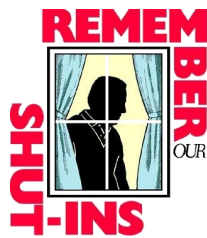
