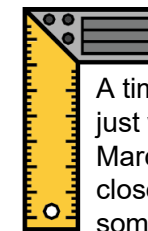

We are hoping to have the directory ready within the next few weeks. Instructions for the online directory will be emailed to each family. Printed copies will also be available upon request. Watch for more details!

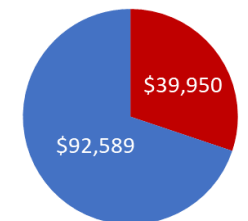


Building to Serve Construction Corner

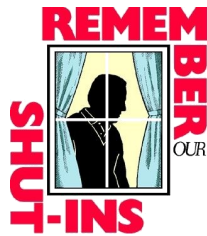

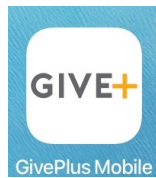

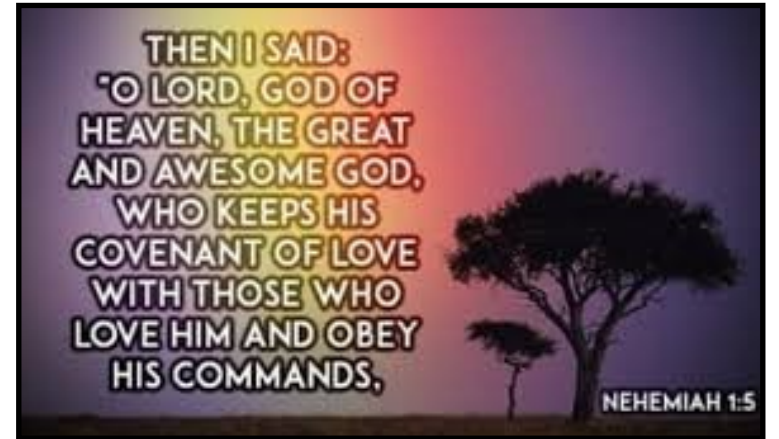
