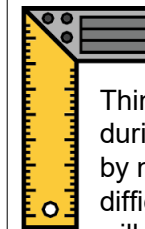

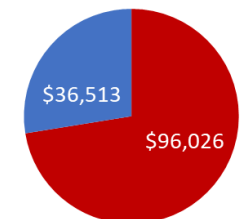
Building to Serve Construction Corner

JUANITA ROBERTS is scheduled for knee replacement surgery on June 18.

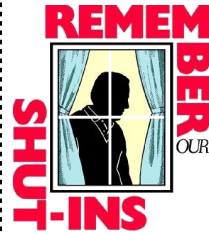

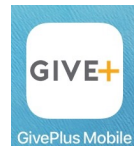
