

Building to Serve Construction Corner



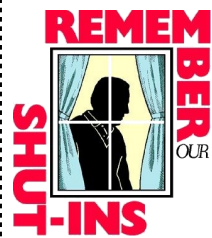

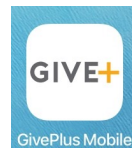
