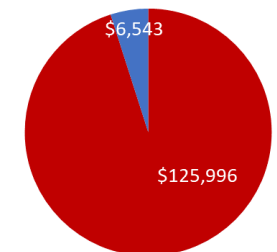
### Building to Serve Construction Corner

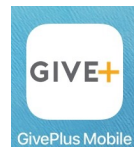
