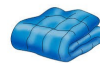

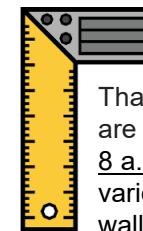
Pick up orders at Faith Baptist Church on October 30.

- 2 years at 1.5%
- 4 years at 1.75%
- 6 years at 2.00%

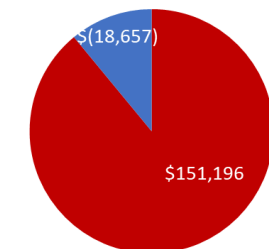
### Building to Serve Construction Corner

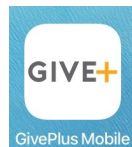
