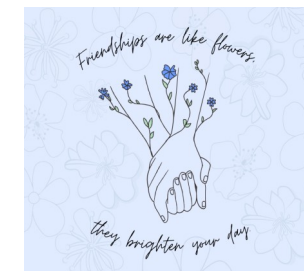
CHURCH MINISTRIES CONFERENCE ♦ March 7 - 8, 2025
